

7% of total CO₂ emissions in the Netherlands come from healthcare sector







Financial impact wastage of medicines

- In total, around 4500 packs of generic medicines are destroyed per day. This amounts to the destruction of 1.6 million packages per year.
- Scientific research (Bekker et al) At least 100 million in medicines per year are destroyed, 40% of which can be prevented.
- (Scientific) research mainly focuses on drug spillage at patients
- Wastage within pharmaceutical supply chain is unknown



PHARMASWAP: HOW DOES IT WORK?



Conditions

Safety and hygiene are always top priority

- ✓ Certified pharmacists only
- ✓Only unopened and undamaged packages
- ✓ Packages were always stored under controlled and monitored conditions in pharmacy
- ✓ Buying pharmacist must have a patients' recipe ready, to guarantee bought goods are used for patient care directly
- ✓ No products that require cooling, or opiates
- ✓ Transportation of packages after a transaction by PharmaSwap logistics partner obligatory

Results:

In 2019 we did a pilot of a few months. The results:

20 participating pharmacists

68 packaging not destroyed, but handed over.

€54.000 saved on purchasing value!

We won first prize!
